The purpose of this page of the application is to verify this student's class rank at the end of his or her sixth semester, or junior year, in high school, as well as his or her current class rank, if different from the sixth-semester rank. The sixth-semester rank is utilized in the scholarship selection process. The student's current class rank is also used as one factor in determining eligibility.

You are welcome to return this part of the application separately, or with the student's official high school transcript and senior class schedule. Please be sure that the student's name and social security number are indicated on this form and on the transcript. This form is a required document which means that we will not render an admission decision until we have the information requested on this form. Full consideration for scholarships will be given to students whose application materials are complete by January 15. Accurate class rank information is a critical element in determining admission status and scholarship selections. The reported sixth semester class size must be the same for all students in the same class attending your school and making application to UNL.

NOTE: In determining class size, do not include foreign exchange students. If your school uses weighted class rank, please report weighted class rank.
